

VBS DEN VOLUNTEER

OVERVIEW

The VBS Den Volunteer supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by leading a small group of children during a weeklong, VBS summer camp.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Help to decorate your "den" for VBS per that year's theme. Supplies will be provided but you are welcome to supplement with your own ideas.
- Arrive in plenty of time to be prepared, set up materials, and be ready to greet and focus on the first arrivers.
- Lead small group activities and discussions as provided by staff and VBS coordinators.
- Create a safe emotional and physical environment by maintaining group control.
- Per the schedule, take your group to their different rotation stations.
- Provide time and space for the children to pray for and with one another.
- Take attendance per the established system.
- Participate in daily prayer with other VBS volunteers before the start of each day.
- Be confident in emergency response procedures and your role in them.
- Complete required safe church training and background check.

RELATIONSHIPS

- The VBS den volunteer is served by Director of Children's & Family Ministries, who ensures the support needed to thrive in this role.
- The VBS den volunteer will have at least one other adult or teen volunteer assisting them.

TIME COMMITMENT

Den set-up and orientation the day before the event (Monday). Duration of the event from 9am-12pm: four days, Tuesday-Friday.

SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Teaching, discernment, hospitality, love for children, ability to relate to children, fun-loving

RESOURCES AND TRAINING

Safe Church training. Materials and orientation provided by church staff and VBS coordinators.
